Dear Co-Workers in the Kingdom,

We have so much to be thankful for! Christ Jesus came into the World to save sinners – that's us! Though we were His enemies, we are now called friends. That's because Christ took our sins upon Himself and sacrificed Himself to make peace with God for us.

Therefore, we wrestle with this question: how should we then live? The best answer is found in 1 John 3:16, "By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren."

Together with you we have sought to live out this verse throughout the year by supporting many faithful missionaries working on the frontlines of world evangelization. Whether they are in the mountains of North India or foreign students at UVA in Charlottesville or working among the unreached in many other nations, we get your support to them. Your prayers and sacrificial offerings have enabled the Kingdom to advance. Only eternity will tell the whole story. Below are some snippets of these victories:

Over a thousand **Afghani** Christians and others were safely relocated beyond the reach of the Taliban. However, there is one last remaining refugee who served our nation faithfully. He is the sole person in a camp that once held 20,000. To say he is discour-aged would be an understatement. His paperwork is perfect, yet no one will help him.

Across the northern belt of the Himalayan Mountains, several ministries served by 24:14 World are faithfully proclaiming the Gospel, often in the face of serious persecution and threats to their families. (India)

In the slums of Manila, Kanlungan ministry continues to rescue children who were sex trafficked, and now they are being clothed, fed and restored through God's Word and the love of the staff. (Philippines)

Help is continuing to be provided for five Boko Haram girls (Nigeria) in the U.S.

Madeline Trotman continues with her one-on-one discipleship of foreign students at UVA and her discipleship of Satish who is working among students in Northern Virginia. Many students are being impacted with the gospel. **(USA)**

A possible future leader of Ethiopia continues to be sheltered by 24:14 World.

Former Muslims from **Somalia** were safely moved into a safer country in the region.

Petals of Hope International continues to faithfully share the Gospel with 100's of girls and boys in Liberia. Pray more friends will come alongside to help support this work that is providing a safe place for young people to grow in their understanding of the Gospel and get a good academic education. **(Liberia)**

A young pastor and his family from Iran were rescued from being deported back to **Iran** where the father would have been imprisoned for his missionary work. Today, they are carrying on their ministry to the Iran church via the internet from **Brazil**.

From the Island of Bali to Central Java, several wonderful ministries in Indonesia continue to reap spiritual fruit.

Hardship and trials are the daily lot of former Muslims who came to faith in Christ in **Malaysia**. They face serious challenges yet remain faithful and fruitful.

In **Israel**, Jewish believers in Christ continue to be faithful even when they find themselves on the frontlines of the conflict. Some are fighting the very people they hope to share the Gospel within the future. Truly this is an upside-down world.

Borewells providing fresh water have opened the way for sharing the gospel in villages in Maharashtra, India.

In Karnataka, India, an investment in a Christian furniture maker has allowed profits to be invested in ministries impacting villages.

African missionaries from **Uganda, Kenya, and Tanzania** attended leadership conferences to strengthen and encourage mission leaders in these countries.

Material blessings were provided to a closed nation off the coast of East Africa.

Chinese missionary, Dorothy Sun, has written two new books in these last years of her life on this earth. They are Everlasting Praises and Chinese Culture, Characters, and the Bible – Reflections and Study Notes. Everlasting Praises tells the story of her father, mother and grandfather whom the Lord used mightily during years of persecution, and Study Notes presents her father's research into biblical stories contained in ancient Chinese pictographs.

The Gospel message was carried to Ukraine, Turkey, the Czech Republic, Spain, Germany, the Caucasus, Poland, and America by Slavik Radchuk and his team. Thanks to your financial support in 2024, they served 39 different ministries. About 17,000 had the opportunity to hear the Gospel message. More than 1,600 people came forward to pray for forgiveness. At the evangelizations in Ukraine, the Czech Republic, and Spain, 60-80 people came forward to repent at each service. For each person saved, all the glory is the Lords. Slavik says there is no greater joy when preaching than that the Spirit of the living Lord through His word captures the listeners. Tears of regret for years lived in unbelief appear in their eyes and then tears of repentance flow. Literally before our eyes in a matter of minutes a person is transformed: a joyful smile appears on the face and confidence that the future will be wonderful.
